CHILD WELFARE POLICY

1. The Club is responsible for ensuring that every child or young person who plays or participates in football with the Club should be able to take part in an enjoyable and safe environment and be protected from abuse.
2. All children and young people have a right to be safe and to be treated with dignity and respect. The Club recognizes its responsibility to safeguard the welfare of all children and young people by protecting them from physical, sexual or emotional harm and from neglect and bullying.
3. The Club holds itself responsible for ensuring that its Code of Conduct is applied, and that all Club personnel working with young people are aware of the importance of, and are fully conversant with, the procedures and practices laid down in the F.A. Child Protection Procedures & Practices Handbook.
4. These procedures apply to anyone involved in Club football including Club Officers, Team Managers and Coaches, Referees, first-aiders, volunteer helpers, parents and spectators.
5. The Club will ensure that all our Team Managers are qualified to a minimum of FA Junior Team Manager standard, and our policy is to provide and fund continuous training and access to F.A. courses, including F.A. Child Protection Workshops, for all adult supervisory personnel.
6. The Club is committed to following the Football Association guidelines for the recruitment of Managers, Coaches and voluntary helpers as laid down in the F.A. Child Protection Procedures and Practices Handbook, and will ensure that all those working with children or young people complete and sign the F.A. Personal Disclosure Form.
